

1. Steps to take your TOEIC test with remote proctoring



You are taking this test as part of a course at a training organisation or academic institution



You will start at Step 1

You are a student, working or looking for a job



Depending on the choice made by your training organisation or academic institution, you will start either at:

Step 1

If you have the option of choosing your test date.

OR

Step 2

If your test date has been set already.

2. STEP 1: Register for a test date

As part of your registration through your professional training organisation or academic institution, you will take the TOEIC test with remote proctoring.

If your institution has set a window to take the test, you may choose your own test date.



You will receive an initial email from ETS Global with the following subject: **A TOEIC test voucher** has been created for you.

Click the "Register for a test with my voucher" button.

Technical specifications for the equipment required on the day of the test



Do you have the right device?

Check now that your computer meets our requirements, so you don't have to worry about it on the day!

Operating system	Microsoft Windows 8.1 or higher, or Mac OS X 10.11 or higher.
Browser	The latest version of Google Chrome with the ProctorExam extension installed.
Internet Connection	We highly recommend an Ethernet connection for better stability or a upload speed of at least 2 Mbps on Wi-Fi.
Camera	External or built into the computer.
Sound system	You must use your computer audio. Headphones, earphones and headsets are not authorised and will lead to score cancellation.
Applications	On both Mac and Windows, deactive live captions and make sure that all apps on your computer are completely closed before the beginning of the test. Restart your computer if necessary.






You must download the Proctor Exam extension first. Click "Download ProctorExam Extension".





The window below will open. Click "Add extension".




The extension will be added. Refresh the page below to start the technical verifications by clicking the icon circled in yellow.



3.3. A piece of advice: organise your test environment

To prepare your environment for the day of the test, meaning the room where you plan to take the test, it is important to be aware of the mandatory security requirements in order to plan for them.

On the day of the test, the room where you plan to take your test must be arranged to meet the following conditions:

- The room must be just for your own use, with no other screens, and there must be no one else but you in the room.
- Your desk must be empty.

A reminder email will be sent to you every Monday before the test date if you have not yet registered.

4. STEP 3: Taking the test

4.1. Test introduction

Before you start, make sure to check the following:

- Are you alone in the room?
- Is the door to the room closed?
- Is your desktop tidy?
- Is your ID on your desk?
- Make sure no connected devices are placed on the desk
- Ensure you are not wearing any watches, headphones or earphones
- Is your computer plugged in?

A 45-minute introduction precedes the test, in order to check the following:

- your equipment
- your environment
- your identity

Following this, the test will begin.



Be careful, do not exceed these 45 minutes or you will be refused access to the test.

It is now time to connect to the test platform by clicking on the connection link that you received by email.





The technical verification process will start at the exact time of the test, the page will automatically refresh.

4.2. Checking your equipment

The following page appears, click on "Set up ProctorExam":



You are prompted to exit any running applications or software with the exception of your Chrome browser. Also quit all your tabs on Chrome, except the Proctor Exam page, and unplug any headphones or other displays and store them in a closet.



It is strictly forbidden to have subtitles on the screen. To disable them in Google Chrome, you need to go to your settings and to the "Accessibility" section.

Note for MAC users:


Not being able to close the Finder application on a MAC computer when taking the TOEIC test with a remote proctoring is well known and accepted.

Quit all Chrome tabs that are open in the Dock:




Take advantage of this instructions' reminder to take a break if necessary, and check again that you are alone, that your desk is tidy and that the room is sufficiently lit.

When you are ready, click the "Next" button




At this stage, allow notifications if a pop-up appears on your screen.







We will now test your computer microphone and speakers.

Say "Hello" to check your microphone after clicking "Test microphone." You will then be asked to click "Test speaker," and will need to answer "No" or "Yes" as to whether you can hear any music coming from your computer speakers.




You will then be asked to check your camera. Click "Test camera," then "Yes" if your image is clearly visible.





4.3. Verifying your identity and environment


Take a close-up photo of your face by placing it in the center of the screen. When you are ready, click "**Take photo**"








We are checking whether your internet connection is stable. Once this has been checked, click "Next"






4.4. Test start: administrative questions and instructions

Once you have answered all the administrative questions, you will see page below.


Click "Continue" to access the test instructions.



4.5. How to navigate the test

For each test question, you need to select the only correct answer among the answers suggested. If you change your mind, click on a new answer.

The Listening section tests your oral comprehension. You cannot listen a second time, nor can you go back.




In the Reading section, you may answer questions in any order, and you may go back.

To validate an answer, press the "Next" button at the bottom right of the screen.

Checking the "Review" box allows you to set the question aside and answer it later.

At any time, you may access a summary of your answers, as well as the status of each one. To return to the questions that still need to be answered, simply click on them.






Note: your browser resolution needs to be adjusted to 100% to see the entire screen.

5. STEP 4: Getting your scores
